Health Requirement and Controls for entry to Sudan

All travellers to Sudan must abide by the following guidelines:

1. Presenting a certificate of vaccination with one of the approved vaccines (one dose of Johnson's vaccine, or two doses of other vaccines. The vaccination is considered valid after 14 days from the date of the last vaccination).
2. If no certified vaccination certificate is provided for the age groups from 8 years and older, a negative PCR test certificate from an approved laboratory is required, with a validity of 72 hours for Arab countries and African countries, 96 hours for European countries, Asian countries, North America, South America, and the Caribbean countries from the date of taking the sample.
3. The Follow-up Form for arrivals to Sudan must be filled out on the plane.
4. In case of suspected COVID-19 infection of a person arriving in Sudan, the suspect shall undergo a laboratory test (PCR or Rapid Examination), provided that the Sudanese Health Authorities shall do the necessary procedures in case of a positive examination.
5. The airline carrier shall bear the costs of quarantine in case of arrival of a person with an unapproved certificate (PCR examination or vaccination certificate) or does not hold one of the said two documents.
6. The airline carrier shall bear the costs of sanitary isolation in case of arrival of a person with a positive examination result.
