Subject: Health prerequisites for returnees or travelers to Sudan regarding COVID-19

The Embassy of the Republic of Sudan in Ottawa would like to convey herewith the directives of the Higher Committee for Health Emergency in the Republic of Sudan, which provided that any passenger travelling to Sudan should hold a medical certificate for COVID-19 testing with a negative result not exceeding 96 hours upon his arrival (4 days). If this condition is not satisfied the passenger may not be allowed to enter the country or may be subject of entering a quarantine for a period of 14 days after his arrival if he has no negative testing result of COVID-19, noting that Airline companies may not allow passengers who are not complying with this requirement to board on planes.

To avoid any inconveniences, any passenger or traveler to Sudan is advised to obtain a medical certificate for COVID-19 testing with a negative result valid for 96 hours prior to his travel.
